Walk To Free the Hostages—Meets at Washington Park every Sunday at 2:00 PM to walk around the lake until all are freed. Meeting place is at Mississippi Avenue, at the entrance to park. Run For Their Lives is a global initiative with over 200 groups around the world, to raise awareness for the immediate release of the hostages still being held in Gaza by the terrorist organization Hamas. Most of the hostages are civilians, including 14 women, 9 elderly over the age of 65, and 2 children. The Denver group runs/walks 1 mile wearing r4tl red shirts, carrying posters of the hostages and Israeli flags. These are family friendly events! To join the WhatsApp group visit run4lives.org.
