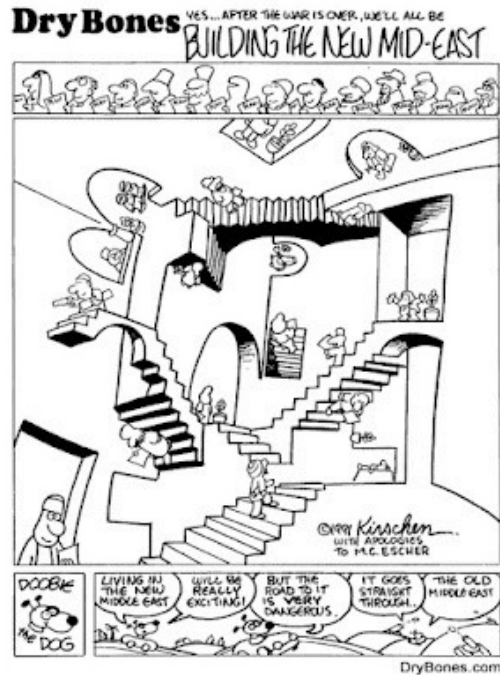
Community Events
