Rav Rosensweig is the Nathan and Perel Schupf Chair in Talmud at RIETS. He is a 1980 graduate of Yeshiva College, and earned an M.A. and a Ph.D. from the Bernard Revel Graduate School. After receiving semicha from RIETS, Rav Rosensweig was among the first group to complete the intensive post-graduate studies in RIETS' Caroline and Joseph S. Gruss Kollel Elyon. Rav Rosensweig was appointed a Rosh Yeshiva, a member of the RIETS faculty, in 1985. He has written extensively, contributing to numerous journals of Torah learning. In 1997, Rabbi Rosensweig was appointed Rosh Kollel (Dean) of the prestigious Israel Henry Beren Institute for Higher Talmudic Studies at RIETS. Rav Rosensweig is known for his intricate conceptual approach to Talmud study, as well as his heavy use of Briske methodology in Talmudic analysis.



Rebbetzin Smadar Rosensweig is a professor of Tanach at Yeshiva University's Stern College for Women. Prior to that she served as professor of Judaic studies and history at Touro College. Rebbetzin Rosensweig received her B.A. from Barnard College and her M.A. ('87) and M.Phil ('89) from Columbia University. Rebbetzin Rosensweig delivers shiurim and lectures extensively throughout the New York metropolitan area and across the country. She is the daughter of Rabbi Dr. David Eliach and Dr. Yaffa Eliach, renowned Holocaust Scholar and professor emeritus at Brooklyn College.
